

GAUGE: 13 sts and 18 rows

SLEEVES (both the same):

CO 28 sts and work 8.5 cm / 3 inches in 4x2 rib.

Then work in St st, making increases as follows:

Row 1 (RS): k1, m1, k to 1 st before the end, m1, k1

Row 2, 4 and 6 (WS): p to the end

Row 3: repeat row 1

Row 5: k to the end

Work the last 6 rows until you have 52 sts.

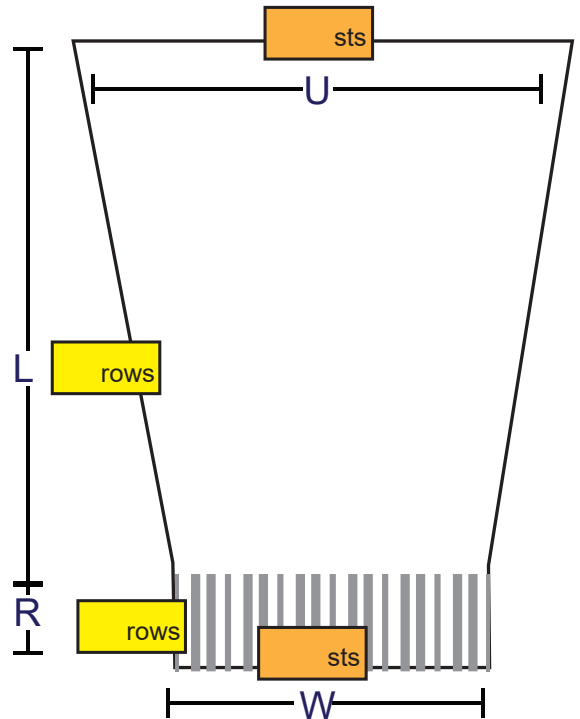
Row 1 (RS): k1, m1, k to 1 st before the end, m1, k1

Row 2 and 4 (WS): p to the end

Row 3: k to the end

Work the last 4 rows until you have 58 sts.

When the sleeve measures 46 cm / 18 inches from CO edge. BO all sts.

Steps to Translate a HK pattern to MK

1. Draw a sketch / highlight
2. Translate gauge to inches
3. Fill in the PATTERN numbers
4. Establish RATIO to your gauge
5. Do the math
6. Use the Magic Formula for the shaping
